
CAMPUS UAH



● Our university operates two campuses in Santiago, Chile.


● Heritage Campus

● Campus B


Campus B is a vibrant and versatile facility tailored for undergraduate and postgraduate education, extension activities, collaborative projects, study areas, and university meetings.

IN-PERSON EXCHANGE PROGRAM

- Universidad Alberto Hurtado has developed an **in-person exchange program** for international students aiming to engage in an academic environment characterized by profound social commitment, critical analysis, and high-quality standards.
- **What are you waiting for to embrace the UAH Jesuit identity?** Pursue your studies in the heart of Santiago at an institution renowned for its commitment to social sciences, humanities, and interdisciplinary dialogue, thereby transforming your academic experience.
- **REQUIREMENTS:**
 - Enroll as a student at a university that has a current exchange agreement with UAH.
 - Proficiency in Spanish at an upper-intermediate level, corresponding to the B2 level of the language.
 - Be nominated by your home institution using our **nomination form**.
 - Complete the **application form for international students** along with the required documentation.

IMPORTANT DATES

STAGES OF THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- The exchange coordinator at your home university is required to nominate you via the **UAH nomination form**.
 - For ODUCAL students, the exchange coordinators at their university should contact the UAH Mobility area to confirm available placements (international@uahurtado.cl).
- Upon nomination, the student is required to complete the **UAH international student application form**.
 - **Required documents:**
 - Historical grade certificate (transcript, academic record).
 - Digital copy of the passport (personal information page).
 - Candidate's letter of motivation.
 - UAH Disclaimer (accessible in the application form).
 - ID Photograph UAH.
 - **For students who do not speak Spanish:** international certification (DELE, SIELE) or a letter from their home university confirming the upper intermediate or B2 level of Spanish.
- The **acceptance letter will be dispatched in Spanish** after the background information of each applicant has been thoroughly reviewed.






ACADEMIC DIMENSIONS

- The UAH degree programs are available for review at the following link: [UAH Undergraduate Degrees](#).
 - Each student must take into account the UAH academic periods, noting that courses from odd semesters are not offered in even semesters and vice versa.
- According to academic regulations, students are required to enroll in a minimum of 30 credits and a maximum of 60 UAH credits.
 - The standard academic workload comprises approximately 50 local credits.
 - A 10-credit UAH course indicates an average commitment of 10 hours of work per week, encompassing both class attendance and independent study.
- The grading scale extends from 1.0 (the lowest grade) to 7.0 (the highest grade), with the minimum passing grade set at 4.0.
- **IMPORTANT:** Certain fields of study may impose restrictions on exchange students. For inquiries, please contact international@uahurtado.cl.

INTENSIVE PROGRAM IN SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CHILEAN CULTURE

- Universidad Alberto Hurtado has developed an **Intensive Spanish Program** tailored for non-Spanish-speaking international students who wish to engage in an immersive academic and cultural experience in the heart of Santiago.
- **What are you waiting for to study Spanish at UAH?** Acquire knowledge while applying your skills in class and throughout the city.
- **REQUIREMENTS:**
 - Enroll as a student at a university that has a current exchange agreement with UAH.
 - Minimum proficiency in Spanish at a high basic level, or A2.
 - Be nominated by your home institution using our **nomination form**.
 - Complete the **application form for international students** along with the necessary documentation.



STAGES OF THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- The intensive Spanish course is conducted prior to the commencement of each semester and is recommended for students whose native language is not Spanish.
 - It necessitates a **minimum number of participants** for execution.
- This program **incurs a cost of \$750,000 CLP** (seven hundred fifty thousand Chilean pesos).

- The exchange coordinator at your home university is required to nominate you via the **UAH nomination form**.
- Upon nomination, the UAH Mobility office will reach out to the student to furnish details regarding the application process and course payment.
 - **Required documentation for the course:**
 - The same documents are required for the In-person Exchange Program, with the exception of the Spanish requirement.
 - International certification (DELE, SIELE) or a letter from your home university validating a Spanish proficiency level of A2 or higher for the course.



ACCOMMODATIONS

- **Universidad Alberto Hurtado does not provide student residences;** therefore, each student must secure their own accommodation during their exchange.

IMMIGRATION MATTERS



- For stays exceeding 180 days, entry into Chile with a **Temporary Residence Permit** for educational purposes (student visa) will be required.
- For stays of fewer than 180 days (1 semester), entry into Chile is permitted with a **Temporary Stay Permit** (for the purpose of studies).
